Mentorship process

If successful, your mentor will reach out to you to arrange a meeting with you. We suggest that you take the opportunity at this meeting to set the expectations of your mentorship, including setting two to three goals that you would like to achieve.

You will connect with your mentor over the course of the remaining school year and summer semester based on a mutually agreed upon schedule. We suggest that you connect every other month, which allows you to connect three to four times during your mentorship.
